

Winter Wonderland Cowl

I created this blend of small and large cables with just a bit of ribbing.

It creates a soft feminine effect against the striping of the Noro. Just like the cold dark tree branches in winter dusted with new fallen snow.



- Materials** 2 Skeins Noro Silk Garden
US #9 24" Circular or size needed to obtain gauge
Cable Needle
1 stitch marker
Blunt darning needle to finish
- Gauge** 5 stitches to an inch
- Size** One Size 28" width, 10" length
- Glossary** K: Knit P: Purl c4f: place 4 st on cable needle & hold to front c2b: place 2 st on cable needle & hold to back k4c and k2c knit stitches from the cable needle
- Body** Cast on 144 stitches. Place marker and Join. Work in K1 P1 ribbing for 4 rounds
- Pattern**
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| Rounds 1 – 3 | P2, K8, P2, K3, P1, K4, P1, K3 Repeat to marker. |
| Round 4 | P2, c4f, k4, k4c, P2, K3, P1, c2b, K2 K2c, P1, K3 Repeat to marker |
| Rounds 5 – 7 | Same as Rounds 1 – 3 |
| Round 8 | P2, K8, P2, K3, P1, c2b, K2, K2c, P1, K3 Repeat to marker |
- Repeat above eight rounds to desired length ending on Round 7
- Work K1 P1 ribbing for 4 rounds
- Finishing** Bind off in Rib. Weave in Ends. Steam Block
