

## *Melted Crayon's*

I loved using the Berroco Boboli yarn for this. The finished look reminds me of a stack of melted crayons.

The cowl is a simple rib with a little rib change up. It is a fast, fun knit, perfect for a beginner or a quick gift.

Finished Measurements One Size 26" diameter and 9 ½" tall

Yarn 1 Skein Berroco Boboli Worsted 10 ply (42% Wool, 35% Acrylic, 23% Rayon 206 yards; 100g)

Needles US 10 24in circular

Notions 1 stitch marker, blunt darning needle to finish

Gauge Gauge is not critical for this, but should be close to 20sts to 4" in 4x4 rib.

Abbreviations **K**: Knit, **P**: Purl, **PM**: place marker.



**Cast On** Cast on 128 stitches. PM and join in the round.

**Ribbing 1** Work K4, P4 Ribbing for 8 inches.

**Ribbing 2** Work K2, P2 ribbing for 1 ½ inches

**Bind Off** Bind off loosely in rib.

**Finishing** Weave in ends. Steam Block if desired.
